TABLE FOR TWO Forgotten History Hunt





The first 6 images are set up in 3 pairs, and each pair has a one-word answer.

Images 7 and 8 are not paired, so each has its own one-word answer.

Example of pairs (this is an example only and adds nothing to the hunt):

- Say the answer to the song is "Stairway to Heaven".
 On its own, this doesn't tell you the one-word answer you are looking for. You need to solve the book to narrow down the answer.
- Then the answer to the book is "The 39 Steps".This narrows down your answer to 'stairs' or 'steps'.

So.

Clues #1&2 together have a one-word answer. Clues #3&4 together have a one-word answer. Clues #5&6 together have a one-word answer. Clues #7 and #8 each have their own one-word answers.

The above answers will lead you to the solution and identify an event from history.

A correct solution will include the words from each of the paired clues, the word from clue #7, the word from clue #8, (for a total of five words), and the event itself.

For an additional bonus prize, include the name of each song and each book when you submit your solution.

There is no limit to how many times you can submit a solution attempt, but you can only win once.

The hunt will remain active until November 23, 2020. At that time, I will draw the names of the winners from all the correct submissions.

As with my past hunts, winners must have a U.S. address.
